

2022 LTAC Funding Meeting – August 2, 2022

A public notice was advertised in the Daily World for 30 days stating that the City would be accepting applications for LTAC funding due by 5:00 p.m. June 17, 2022 as well as on the City webpage. Six applications were submitted by the deadline of the 17th, with two additional applications submitted after the cutoff date.

The LTAC Committee recommends that the Council approve the total funding requests for the six projects submitted by the deadline and award \$2,500 to Polson for new signage and \$2,500 to Loggers' Playday for stadium rental for the show.
