**III. STATEMENT OF FACTS**

Brian Bassett is before this Honorable Court for re-sentencing pursuant to RCW 10.95.030, a *Miller-fix* statute. See, *State v. Bassett*, 19 Wa. App. 1035 (2021), (2021 WL 4859840).

Based upon delays in receiving necessary information/records from the Department of Corrections, the availability of witnesses and/or relatives with the right to attend, and the schedules of counsel for both parties, the parties have agreed that a continuance of the June 8, 2022 hearing date is necessary.
